MATTING MAINTENANCE RECOMMENDATIONS

DAILY CLEANING FOR CONNEXX

Daily use of a good upright vacuum cleaner will remove loose dirt because of the rotary brush action. An additional benefit of the brush action is to groom the pile of thus helping to reduce pile flattening.

We do not recommend the use of a suction only machine such as a tub vacuum cleaner because it cannot successfully remove the dirt from the textile strips due to the impervious backing of the matting, nor will it have the grooming effect on the pile.

PERIODIC CLEANING

The frequency of cleaning will depend upon the volume of traffic over the matting, the time of year and the level of soiling at site. Clean using a hot water extraction machine, paying particular attention to the textile inserts. The temperature should not exceed **50°C**.

Chewing Gum

Discarded chewing gum should be dealt with promptly before becoming hardened and engrained into the carpet surface. It can be removed using freeze spray technology or by use of proprietary gum removing gels, and subsequently scraped out of the carpet pile.

Spot Cleaning

Stubborn stains should be treated on a localised basis with a solvent-based spot remover, of which several are available in the market place.

DONT'S

Do not use counter rotating brush type vehicular cleaning machinery.
Do not use orbital type polishing equipment over matting.
Do not use any bleaching cleaning agents, use instead PH neutral.
Do not use a Bonnet Buffering type machine.
